SENIOR HIGH MISSION TRIP:

In Order To Attend The 2025 Mission Trip All Participants Must Follow One Of The Three Plans In Order To Raise Adequate Funds For The Mission Trip.

ALL STUDENTS ATTENDING THE MISSION TRIP Will Pay a Registration Fee: \$50 and A Payment Of \$300. Depending on how fundraising works and donations made to the ministry this price could drop.

Current Fundraisers:

- <u>STEARNS COUNTY Fair Stand:</u> We thank all families for their assistance at this year's fair stand. Your continued assistance and support helps benefit our church and our youth mission trips. This takes place the last week of July.
- <u>Cookie and Lefse Fundraiser:</u> Sunday December 8, 2o24 We will need students to sell the cookies and lefse on December 8. Cookie donations will be needed from Mission Trip and SLA families. We will also need students to decorate cookies, and bake lefse on Saturday December 7,2024. Mission Trip participants ARE REQUIRED to help out at this fundraiser.
- <u>Spaghetti Supper:</u> Sunday March 16, 2025. We will need students to serve at the Spaghetti and Lefse fundraiser. Donations like Meat, Carrots, etc will also be needed from Mission Trip and SLA families. (ALL Mission Trip participants ARE REQUIRED To help out at this fundraiser.

Soup and Sandwich suppers, WOW dinners, and the Palm Sunday Breakfast are Youth fundraisers but their funds go to various elements of our youth ministry and not just

mission trips. So Cookie and Lefse, and Spaghetti Supper are Exclusively Mission Trip Fundraisers.

MISSION TRIP F.A.Q's

1) What group are we using to do our mission trip this summer?

A: For several summers FLC has had luck sending students on mission trips using the ministry YouthWorks which is based out of Golden Valley, MN. They have a reputation for creating experiences for young people in every denomination.

2) What are we doing in our selected community this summer?

A: Rapid City is a Small Urban community and students will be asked to participate in a number of activities including visiting with members in assisted living communities, minor home repairs, working at a food kitchen, and a local Boys and Girls club.

3) Who Can Go On This Mission Trip?

A: All youth in Grades 6 - 8 are invited to participate in this mission trip. FLC reserves the right to ask young people to NOT participate if behavior is a concern.

4) How Are We Getting There This Summer?

A: This summer ALL FLC trips will be driving only, For trips that are longer than 3 hours to drive the new requirement is that there will be two driving adults per vehicle taken. NO adult should be driving for longer than 3 hours at a time in order to make sure that all are well rested and safe to transport students.

5) How much is it going to cost to go on the mission trip this summer?

A: To send a participant on a mission trip from First Lutheran and this includes registration with YouthWorks and transportation to and from site it will cost \$600 per participant. FLC is asking all families for \$350 per participant to be paid between time of registration and May 2025.

- The Mission Trip Fundraising Team will be working to offset this cost in whatever way possible.
- FLC strongly encourages families to come and talk if this cost is TOO much we have scholarship opportunities available.

6) Can I bring my friend or friends?

A: If your friend is a member of First Lutheran the invitation is open to ALL members of FLC. If your friend is not a member of FLC they may still fill out a registration form. Once forms are submitted Joe will schedule a 5 minute call with their parents to make sure they are a good fit for our mission trip team.

7) When is the registration deadline?

A: The registration deadline will be November 20, 2024. At this time we are strongly encouraging young people and families to pray about this upcoming summer and to see if this is an opportunity that God is calling them to do.
